RE: 2013-14 Basketball Season

This note replaces the captain's meeting. You are responsible to share this information along with information in the team registration packet and player code of conduct, to your teammates so that we can avoid unnecessary captain's meetings in the future. Season schedules are now at www.crlasports.com and at the Casper Recreation Center.

Rules

All rules will go by NFHS. The exceptions to these rules are located in your team registration packets. If you have lost or thrown away that packet it is posted online and attached. Please read over these exceptions and be familiar with NFHS basketball rules.

Player Eligibility

Team managers are welcome to review the score sheets at the scorer's table at any time during their game. If the manager notices a non-rostered player he/she may protest the game. All protests should be handled immediately. If the team refuses to be honest about the eligibility of a player, photo identification must be presented. If the said player does not have photo identification he/she must present photo ID to the Casper Rec. Center by 12:00pm the next day or the game will be forfeited and the forfeit fee will apply. **Once a game has ended, player protests will not be honored.** Just a reminder: Players to be added to your roster must do so no later than the start time of that night's game. A receipt must be present to the scorekeeper if the player is registered the night of. A player can only be registered for one team. **We cannot delay the start of a game to wait while your player pays to get on the roster, game time is forfeit time.**

Uniforms

The uniform rule goes into effect Monday, January 6, 2014. Uniforms must have numbers and be of the same color and style. Players not conforming to the uniform guidelines as described in the manager's packet must wear a pinnie jersey and will get a technical foul upon first entry into the game.

Sportsmanship

We expect the best sportsmanship in the Casper Recreation Leagues Association. You are responsible to read over the Player Code of Conduct and make sure your teammates are informed. Information regarding technical fouls and consequences are in the Basketball Team Packet. Just a reminder: **any** foul language directed to an official, an official's call, another player, game staff, spectators, or anyone else will result in an immediate ejection from the game and suspension as outlined in the player code of conduct. This applies to all participants of the basketball game whether they are playing, sitting on the bench, being a spectator, etc.
